






**Wadsworth Falls** - Enjoy hiking on the varied trails of the park or spend some time enjoying the beautiful falls. Spend your afternoon at the designated swimming and picnic area of the park. Lunch will be provided, must have your order into Jaclyn [by Aug 5<sup>th</sup>](#). Choices of ham, turkey, or veggie option, drink included.



A visit to **Hammonasset Beach State Park** is more than just another day at the beach. Connecticut's largest shoreline park offers over 2 miles of beach to enjoy swimming, strolling along the boardwalk, or just relaxing in the sun and surf. Enjoy a seafood lunch at Lenny & Joes.

Enjoy a 45 minute live narrated boat ride during the **Thimble Island Boat Tour**. You will hear about the natural history of the islands, the shell fish industries that thrived in town and the building boom that occurred during the Victorian Era. We recount old stories and local legends and you will see picturesque scenery, including beautiful homes and shore birds. Admission \$12. (There must be at least 10 people signed up in order for this trip to go!)



At the **Museum of Connecticut History**, you'll find exhibits that trace the growth of the State and its role in the development of the nation. The Museum focuses on Connecticut's government, industrial and military history. No admission fee.

**Dinosaur State Park** is one of the largest dinosaur track sites in North America. Beneath our geodesic dome, you will find an exceptional display of early Jurassic fossil tracks that were made 200 million years ago. Surrounding our Exhibit Center are more than two miles of nature trails and the Dinosaur State Park Arboretum, containing more than 250 species and cultivars of conifers, as well as katsuras, ginkgos, magnolias and other living representatives of plant families which appeared in the Age of Dinosaurs.
