**Roseland Cottage's** picturesque landscape includes original boxwood-edged parterre gardens planted in the 1850s. The entire complex of house, furnishings, outbuildings, and landscape reflects the principles of Andrew Jackson Downing, a leading nineteenth-century tastemaker. Admission \$9
