DURHAM PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE

Minutes of the Meeting, January 5,2010

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 PM. Frank DeFelice, Jim Rossi, Bill Smith, Dan Murphy and Wendy Manemeit were present. Also in attendance was Resident State Trooper Pete DiGioia . A motion to accept the minutes of last months meeting was approved by 4 members (DeFelice, Rossi, Murphy & Smith). Wendy Manemeit abstained.

The Public Safety sign that is Kyle Backus's Boy Scout Eagle project and is to be located at the firehouse has been approved by the Connecticut Department of Transportation. The committee will generate a suggested list of messages for Board of Selectman approval.

The second phase of the Neighborhood Watch program was discussed. The committee has identified two areas for the next phase of the project. A tentative presentation for the neighborhoods is scheduled for the March, 2010 meeting. The committee also agreed to use a combination of the towns emergency notification system and e-mail for notifying and maintaining contact with interested participants.

Bill Smith informed the committee that the speed bumps for Town House Road have been selected but have not been ordered. He also informed the committee that the town has purchased new street signs. He will monitor efforts to ensure that all residences have the house number in a visible location for emergency services.

The committee agreed to request that its present budget level remain the same for next years proposed budget.

There being no additional business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:45 PM. The next scheduled meeting is February 2,2010.
