Minutes of the Meeting, February 2,2010

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 PM. Frank DeFelice, Jim Rossi, Bill Smith and Dan Murphy were present. Also in attendance were Resident State Trooper Pete DiGioia and Emergency Management Director Francis Willett. . The minutes of the previous months meeting were read and accepted.

The new Neighborhood Watch Program was discussed. The administration, set up and layout of regions was discussed.

Dan Murphy discussed the suggested topics for articles submitted to The Town Times for publication. The committee will review and comment on the topics for the next meeting.

Bill Smith showed the committee a picture of the 4 speed bumps that will be installed on Town House Road. He will continue to work with the Department of Public Works on the procurement and installation and report back to the committee.

The suggested messages for the Public Safety sign to be installed on Main Street was discussed. The committee feels that the four emergency agencies in town (Fire, Ambulance, State Police and Emergency Management) should alternate messages on both sides of the sign. The committee will develop a list of typical messages for Board of Selectman and emergency agency approval.

Bill Smith informed the committee about the street numbering system. Street signs will be replaced and standardized over the next three years due to federal regulations.

There being no additional business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:51 PM.

The next scheduled meeting is March 2,2010.
