Minutes of the Meeting, March 3,2009

The meeting was called to order at 6:35 PM. Members Frank DeFelice, Jim Rossi, Dan Murphy, Bill Smith and Wendy Manemeit were present. Reading of the previous months meeting was waived due to it being cancelled for failure to achieve a quorum. A motion was made, seconded and approved unanimously to modify the published agenda to allow public comment before any published businesses was discussed tonight.

A resident made a comment concerning snow plowing where state and town roads meet. Large piles are blocking the line of sight when attempting to pull onto state roads. The committee will investigate who plows what and attempt to correct the problem.

Kyle Backus of the Boy Scouts asked the committee for permission to work on the proposed public safety sign as his Eagle Badge project. The committee voted unanimously to allow the project to proceed and provide any support needed. Richard Parmalee addressed the committee on the positive aspects of the Connecticut State Police
