## **DURHAM PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE**

Minutes of the Meeting, October 6,2009

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 PM. Members Frank DeFelice, Jim Rossi, Dan Murphy, Bill Smith, Wendy Manemeit and Mal Pierce were present. The minutes of the previous months meeting were accepted

Frank DeFelice reported to the committee the details of a meeting he had with the First Selectman. Durham Resident State Trooper DiGioia and Connecticut State Police Sergeant Calvo. Previous and future Blockwatch procedures were discussed. Use of the emergency phone notification system for communication with Blockwatch members was discussed. The committee plans to expand the Blockwatch network next year, with distribution of flyers announcing meetings to neighborhoods and announcements on the towns website.

The next public safety announcement in the "Town Times" was discussed. Topic ideas included Halloween safety, winter driving and winter ice/snow storm preparation.

Bill Smith is still investigating traffic calming options with the director of Public Works.

The house numbering program was discussed. Methods and procedures for notifying residents whose house number is not visible from the street were reviewed. There being no additional business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:24 PM.
