## **DURHAM PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE**

Minutes of the Meeting, December 1, 2009

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 PM. Frank DeFelice, Mal Pearce, Jim Rossi Bill Smith and Dan Murphy were present. Also in attendance were Resident State Trooper Pete DiGioia and Francis Willet. A motion to accept notice of the cancellation of last months meeting was unanimously approved.

The committee discussed the proposed meeting dates for 2010. The committee decided unanimously to continue meeting on the first Tuesday of every month.

Francis Willet gave the committee a presentation of the towns emergency notification system in support of the expansion of the Neighborhood Watch Program. The number and sizes of Neighborhood Watch districts and methods of contact with participants was discussed.

Trooper DiGioia informed the committee of new police equipment the town has purchased. A new police traffic radar system, a laser radar gun and a small portable SMART radar system were among the items purchased with federal stimulus monies. The grant paid for 100% of the cost of these items.

Bill Smith will follow up on house numbering enforcement procedures.

There being no additional business, the meeting was adjourned at 9:01 PM. The next scheduled meeting is January 5, 2010.
