Preparation of materials for transport and disposal

- * Dry material must be in closed containers such as plastic bags and labeled.
- * Do not mix materials.
- * All materials must be labeled.
- * Tighten all lids on containers.
- * Pack containers in sturdy boxes.
- * Transport material in automobile trunk, rear of station wagon, or truck bed.
