Update to operational changes:

Mail: The Town Clerk/ Assistant Town Clerk will be checking the mail and processing land records, vital requests, etc., twice a week on Tuesdays and Fridays.

eRecording: (Attorneys, banks, etc.,) Setting up an eRecording account will allow your recording to be processed and returned immediately to you. The following link provides information for delivery agents:

Recording Land Records: If you do not have an eRecording account, please mail all recordings via USPS to: Town Clerk, P.O. Box 428, Durham, CT 06422. Provide an email address for recording information.

Land Records Availability: The Town of Durham land records (1947 to present) and survey maps are available to view online for free at: <https://www.searchiqs.com/ctdur/Login.aspx>. You can print copies of land records and maps and pay by credit card. Use the "Search" tab for information 1967 to present; use the "Indexbooks" tab for 1947-1966 Grantor/Grantee index and all survey maps.

Funeral Homes, Filing of Death Certificates, Burial and Cremation Permits: Please call the Town Clerk's office (860)349-3453 to set up an appointment. The Town Clerk will process your request while you wait in your car.

Absentee Balloting: The Presidential Preference Primary has been rescheduled a second time to August 11, 2020. If you have already mailed in your absentee ballot application you do not need to send in another; we will use the application on hand.
