Subject: Notice of Preliminary Alteration of the Boundaries of the Public Water Supply Management Areas and the Priorities for Initiation of the Water Utility Coordinating Committee (WUCC) Planning Process

The Department of Public Health (DPH) is notifying appropriate parties regarding the alteration of the boundaries of the public water supply management areas and the priorities for initiation of the Water Utility Coordinating Committee (WUCC) planning process. The Notice of Hearings, attached to which is the map containing the preliminary alteration of the boundaries of the public water supply management areas, is enclosed (Notice). Please note that the DPH is holding two public hearings, one on May 15, 2014, in Brookfield and the other on May 19, 2014, in Norwich. The DPH will also accept written comments on the preliminary alteration of the boundaries of the public water supply management areas and the priorities for initiation of the WUCC planning process until May 23, 2014.

Town clerks are requested to post the Notice in the town hall. Additionally, please feel free to share the Notice with any additional town agencies and commissions.

The WUCC process was developed in 1985 under state law to address regional and statewide water supply planning. The DPH is currently proposing to alter the boundaries of the public water supply management areas and the priorities for initiation of the WUCC planning process. After the altered boundaries of the public water supply management areas and the priorities are finalized, the DPH will convene a water utility coordinating committee for each public water supply management area to implement the WUCC planning process.
